

## **DOVER WATER RESOURCES COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES - February 10, 2021**

Held remotely via zoom

**Present:** Professor Gerald Clarke, Chairman; Carol Lisbon, Greg Kahoun, Justine Kent-Uritam, Ron Myrick, members

**Guests:** Stephen Kruskall, M.D.; Kay Petersen, M.D.; Robert Zockoff

1. Meeting called to order 8:01 am
2. Justine and Carol requested that a one page water conservation educational insert go out in the next property tax bill, estimated to cost \$125. It was determined that adequate funds were available to move forward with the proposal.
3. There was a discussion of a proposed draft Hydrology Study budget request for fiscal 2022 based on recommendations and estimated costs by Kleinfelder.  
Key points:
  - Transducers and loggers to be checked and maintained in working order
  - Monitor and capture of well and stream data over time
  - Data analysis and recommendations
  - PWS data to be gathered and analyzed
  - Education outreach for water conservation
  - GIS support
4. The Committee recommended to the Board of Health that it vote to approve the document as presented by Ron at its next meeting.
5. Greg noted that the town's Technology Advisory Board had been informed of a GIS upgrade. It was deemed essential for the new position of Land Use Director. The committee voiced concerns as to how to insure that all current information from the study would get onto the town's GIS.
6. Joe Cerutti, DEP, and Jodi Lyn Cutler, Coordinator for MA PFAS private well testing program, presented proposed well locations for sampling. They wanted to know if there were other areas in town that should also be targeted. They requested additional information on the number and extent of public water systems in town. The proposed introductory meeting at noon on February 17, 2021 was confirmed.
