

## **Meeting of the Dover Board of Health/Dover Water Resources Committee February 17, 2021**

1. Meeting was called to order 12:01 pm
2. Jodi Lyn Cutler, Program Coordinator, presented an overview of the MassDEP Private Well PFAS Sampling Program.
3. Key points mentioned:
  - The PFAS 6 are the most used of the 'forever' chemicals
  - The testing standard is 6 parts per trillion
  - Testing is free for well owners accepted into the program
  - 20-40 private well owners will be chosen
  - All residents with private wells may apply, whether or not an invitation to participate was issued
  - Benefit of testing - knowing what is in your drinking water
  - Towns may not opt out; well owners may decide to participate or not
  - Program seeking potential PFAS sites such as landfills, fire fighting foam usage, manufacturing, etc.
  - A map of potential sites was presented to identify possible areas of interest
  - If contamination is found, the Bureau of Wastewater Clean-up will contact the well owner.
  - Currently there is no state funding available to well owners for remediation
4. Professor Clarke and Karl Warnick, Dover Water Operator, reviewed several addresses and indicated which were serviced by a public water system.
5. Information about the program will be sent out via email and social media.
