### 1. Town House Roof

Estimates obtained from third parties: \$613,000-\$678,000 without design and engineering services.

Review of quality of GAF v CertainTeed.

50-year warranty.

Vendor uses Eagle View Report: Calculates area of roof, gutter lines, pitches, flashing.

Recommends rubber membrane for flat roof portion.

The Committee approves and recommends that the Town House Roof be replaced with new architectural shingles, GAF or equivalent, and all other materials and supplies required for other portions of the roof, including design and engineering services in an amount not to exceed \$700,000.
