

# Dover Board of Health COVID-19 Meeting Minutes

## 3/25/2021

Held remotely via zoom

Meeting called to order 11:02 am

1. Consultation proposal - Kay has identified another potential applicant for the role as outside evaluator of the procedures and staffing of the BOH.
2. In-home vaccination of the house-bound-The state program to which Dover has subscribed is proceeding. The COA is forwarding to the state a list of Dover residents qualified for this program. Alyssa has stated that Advantage Nursing Care has already fully vaccinated its clients in Dover.
3. Dover Cruise Nights-Recent changes in state guidelines permitting such an event will be reviewed by the Board. A public meeting of the Board with the organizers of this weekly warm weather event on the Town Common was felt necessary prior to BOH approval.
4. Library - The Board felt that a public meeting with Cheryl Abdullah and a library trustee should occur prior to its issuing approval for the library's expansion of its reopening.
5. Town Meeting- Kay reported on the status of the current planning for this year's annual Town Meeting in May.
6. Gerry reported on his recent meetings with the town's Conservation Commission and Warrant Committee.
7. A motion was made by Kay for the Board to withdraw from this year's Town Warrant the BOH-sponsored line item seeking funding for additional BOH personnel hours. This motion was withdrawn for lack of a second.

At 12:00 pm a motion was made and seconded to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed unanimously.
