

**DOVER CEMETERY COMMISSIONER'S MEETING
MARCH 28, 2023**

At 4:00 PM Chair Peg Crowley called the meeting to order with Carol Jackman and Mariah Riess in attendance.

Citizens' Comments – No citizens in attendance.

1.1 Approval of Meeting Minutes

On a motion by Carol Jackman and seconded by Mariah Riess the minutes of January 31, 2023 were approved unanimously.

1.2 Deeds
