

## **DOVER WATER RESOURCES COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES - JUNE 9, 2021**

Held remotely via zoom

1. Meeting called to order 8:07 am
2. Justine made a motion to approve the meeting minutes of May 5, 2021. The motion was seconded by Carol and passed unanimously.
3. Gerald reported on the most recent findings of the MA Drought Management Task Force.
4. Robert indicated that both Natick and Wellesley have water restrictions in place; Natick has the ability to draw water from Elm Bank as long as there is no declaration of drought; Wellesley may obtain water from the MWRA in drought conditions. He also noted that it is water quality, not just quantity, that is looked at when the state decides to issue a declaration of drought.
5. Jenna Day of Recap Solutions gave an overview of the North Central Private Well Program. She acknowledged that statewide regulations for private wells may be developed. She anticipated that approximately one thousand wells will have been tested by the end of the 5 year program.
6. Robyn reported that the Board of Selectmen is looking to have dedicated staff assist in data collection from the monitoring wells.
7. Carol reported that the Board of Selectmen is planning to hire a consultant to input the GIS data.
8. Action Items:
  - Post only one (sign) message at a time
  - Ron Myrick to work with Karl Warnick on data collection
  - Verify funding and proceed with Kleinfelder contract
  - Planning intern to work on social media for water conservation

9. Carol made a motion seconded by Justine to acquire additional signage for water conservation. The motion passed unanimously.
10. Carol made a motion seconded by Justine to create a water conservation write-up to go out with the next tax bill. The motion passed unanimously. Justine will speak with Mona about the process.
11. At 9:55 am it was moved and seconded to adjourn the meeting. The motion was approved unanimously.
