

MEETING MINUTES OF THE DOVER BOARD OF HEALTH - JULY 12, 2021

Held remotely via zoom

Present: Professor Gerald Clarke, Chair; Stephen Kruskall, M.D., member; Kay Petersen, M.D., Member; Agent Michael Angieri, Septic Systems

1. Meeting called to order 7:00 pm
2. Dr. Kruskall made a motion, seconded by Dr. Petersen, to approve the meeting minutes of June 7, 2021. The motion passed unanimously.
3. 1 Cedar Hill Road - A motion was made by Professor Clarke and seconded by Dr. Petersen to approve septic system design plans dated June 19, 2021 and a deed covenant for a 4 bedroom house with no garbage grinder subject to the owner(s) signing the deed covenant and final review by the Septic Systems Agent. The motion was unanimously approved.
4. 14 Sherbrooke Drive - A motion was made by Professor Clarke and seconded by Dr. Petersen to approve septic system design plans dated June 12, 2021 for an Eljen system and a deed covenant for a 4 bedroom house with no garbage grinder subject to the owner(s) signing the deed covenant and final review by the Septic Systems Agent. The motion was unanimously approved.
5. 4 Cranberry Lane - A motion was made by Professor Clarke and seconded by Dr. Petersen to approve septic system design plans dated June 10, 2021 for an Eljen system and a deed covenant for a 3 bedroom house with no garbage grinder subject to the owner(s) signing the deed covenant and final review by the Septic Systems Agent. The motion was unanimously approved.
6. Well report - Professor Clarke reported on behalf of Agent Zemel that an additional well is to be drilled at 5 Wilson's Way
7. Trash Haulers - Ms. Lisbon spoke on behalf of the Recycling Committee. The Committee is requesting that if/when the Board decides to create new regulations for trash haulers, it consider the following:
 - A requirement to submit the number of households the trash hauler services
 - A requirement that the tonnage amount for both trash and recycling be reported on a set schedule.

8. Consultants - There was a discussion on the procurement process for the consultants. The Board decided to contact a few more prospective individuals and/or firms before making its decision.
9. Tick signs - Changes to the tick signs were discussed. It was decided that the wording would be changed to include more specific personal protection information.
10. Dr. Petersen suggested COVID messaging go out again this week as cases in Massachusetts are rising. The message will focus on the need to get vaccinated.
11. At 8:30 pm it was moved and seconded to adjourn the meeting. The motion was approved unanimously.
