The Board thanked and expressed its appreciation to the men and women of the Department for their participation, in tribute, to Chief Hughes and his family at the Wake at the George H. Dougherty Funeral Home in Wellesley on July 23, 2021. And, then again on July 24 at the funeral service and celebration of his life at the Most Precious Blood Church in Dover and graveside service at the Highland Cemetery in Dover.

The Board also recognized the following Fire Departments who provided mutual aid and coverage to the town over July 23 & 24: Franklin, Medfield, Natick, Norfolk Sherborn and Sharon.

Chief Craig Hughes's service to the Dover Fire Department will always be admired and appreciated. He cared for the men & women of the Department with his number one concern for their safety and for his and their dedication to the citizens of Dover.
