

Minutes Dover Board of Health 5pm meeting August 18, 2021

Present; Gerald Clarke, Kay Petersen, Stephen Kruskall

Meeting called to order at 5:00 pm

1. The annual "Up in Smoke" barbecue sponsored by the "Friends of the COA" is scheduled for September 1st. Linda Pettit detailed the actual plans for this barbecue to the Board. The Board voted to approve the plans as discussed with a recommendation that an outdoor tent be obtained to serve as a canopy as a contingent plan should inclement weather occur. The Board opted to not issue a mandatory masking requirement for this event.

2. The "Dover Days Fair" is scheduled to take place outdoors on September 11th. At this time the Board, other than recommending that the inflatable balloon event not occur, had no objections to the planning for this event proceeding.

3. Parks and Rec, with the exception of indoor art classes, is holding all its scheduled events outdoors this fall. Mark Ghiloni will be invited to meet with the Board to elaborate further on these plans.

4. 5pm, Tuesday, August 24th was selected as the time to meet with MAPC regarding this firm's application for the consulting role.

5. Candidate Kwok received favorable reviews from Gerald Clarke and Kay Petersen regarding Mr Kwok's recent interview for the BOH open part-time position.

6. Discussion will continue with CVS to serve as the facilitator for this fall's flu clinic....Because of the challenges of medical decision-making regarding which pneumococcal vaccine is appropriate for each citizen, it was decided not to administer the various pneumococcal vaccines at this fall clinic.

7. Discussion took place regarding the paucity of applicants for the open-part time administrative BOH position. The non-competitiveness of the salary offered for this position by the town was cited as a major reason for the small applicant pool.
