Citizens' Comments

1.1 Approval of Meeting Minutes

On a motion by Mariah Riess and seconded by Fred Sears the minutes of July 30, 2024 were approved unanimously.

1.2 Deeds

1.4 Autumn Meditation Planting

Rusty reported that the lowering device he uses for full burial funerals is not working properly, it is very old and needs to be replaced. He presented two quotes for an Imperial Lowering Device made of Stainless Steel. A motion by Carol, seconded by Mariah, was made and approved unanimously to purchase the Device at a cost of \$4,638.82 from FCC Lowering Devices.
