Chief Luttazi informed us that there are 6 applicants for the two positions of Lieutenant. Their information will be sent to the Board from the Dover Town House after their consultation with Town Council. The Board anticipates interviews may commence within the next two weeks.

Officers Report: there were 25 Fire, and 15 Ambulance calls during the month. Three new EMT's are in training and another application is in line for training. There are 22 EMT's on the Department. There have been a few attendance issues which the Chief is dealing with mainly during the daytime when the Department has had to call for backup from other towns. The Ambulance/EMT team is getting ready for the State inspection which will happen this month.

The combined Fire & Police Department September/11 Remembrance Service was held outside the station and had good attendance. This was followed by the Departments participation in Dover Days. On September 18 the Department hosted along with the Police Department a combined Open House which was a success for both Departments and attendees.

On October 18 at the Highway garage the Department will train with the extraction devices. On November 6 the Department will participate in Med Flight training at the Haven Street field at 10:30am.

Our next scheduled monthly meeting is November 1, 2021, at 5:00pm at the station.
