**RE: Dover Board of Health Order - Face Masks**

Due to the increase in COVID-19 cases and out of an abundance of caution, the Board of Health has issued an order requiring face masks in all municipal and other buildings open to the public in the Town of Dover, **effective Monday, September 13**. The Town of Dover municipal buildings include the Town House, Caryl Community Center, Dover Town Library, Protective Agencies Building, and the Highway Garage.

Those who are exempt from the face coverings requirement include:

- Children under two (2) years of age
- Individuals who cannot wear a mask due to medical conditions or disabilities
- Employees who are alone in private offices with the door closed
- Patrons of food service establishments who are eating / drinking

Please note that the Town's COVID-19 Protocols from December 14, 2020 have largely stayed the same. **Remember: If you have any doubt if you should enter a Town Building with symptoms, stay home and get tested!** The safety and wellbeing of the general public and staff has been our top priority and we greatly appreciate everyone's patience and understanding during this time.
