**ARTICLES OF THE WARRANT
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING October 7, 2019**

Norfolk, ss.

To any of the Constables of the Town of Dover in said County, Greetings;

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Dover, qualified as the Constitution requires to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet in the Alan Mudge Auditorium at the Dover-Sherborn Regional High School in said Town on Monday, the 7th day of October, 2019, at seven o'clock in the evening then and there to act on the following articles, to wit:

Article 1. (Selectmen) DEVELOP COST ESTIMATES AND PRELIMINARY DESIGN PLANS FOR A RENOVATED CARYL COMMUNITY CENTER

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, appropriate by transfer from available funds, or any combination of these methods, a sum of money for the purpose of conducting feasibility studies and developing cost estimates and architectural and engineering plans for the repair and renovation of the existing Caryl Community Center, including all services incidental and related thereto; or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 2. (Selectmen) DEVELOP COST ESTIMATES AND PRELIMINARY DESIGN PLANS FOR A NEW COMMUNITY CENTER



Hereof fail not and make due return of the Warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at or before the time of the Meeting.


